The Carter Wosk BC Creative Achievement Awards for Applied Art and Design celebrate British Columbians who through their creativity contribute to the cultural and economic fabric of the Province.

The awards recognize artists and individuals whose work has a practical function. Individuals who work in jewelry, glass, wood, fibre, clay and metal or in such areas, but not limited to, textiles, furniture, weaving, ceramics, fashion and industrial design are eligible.

Both established and emerging artists and designers are invited to apply. Up to three awards will be presented annually.

Juried by an Advisory Panel of experienced individuals in the field of applied art and design, the awards represent excellence.

The awards are named in honour of two distinguished British Columbians: Dr. Yosef Wosk, cultural philanthropist, whose generosity makes these awards possible; and Sam Carter, teacher and advocate for applied art and design.

The awards are presented by the BC Achievement Foundation, an independent foundation established and endowed in 2003 by the Province to celebrate excellence in community service, arts, humanities and enterprise.

Up to three recipients will be awarded \$2,500 each at a presentation and exhibition event to be held in the Fall of 2010. The recipients will be granted the use of the British Columbia Creative Achievement Award seal to signify their creative excellence.

A citizen or permanent resident of Canada, who has been a resident of British Columbia for the past three years is eligible to apply. Posthumous submissions will not be accepted.

An individual may submit his or her work or another individual may nominate a person for this award.

## SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

The Advisory Panel will assess the submissions and nominations and select the recipients based on the material provided and the following criteria:

*creativity*  
*originality*  
*innovative approach*  
*aesthetics*

The decision of the Advisory Panel is final.

The British Columbia Achievement Foundation reserves the right to withhold awards if the entries received do not meet the excellence criteria of the program.

## SUBMISSION PACKAGE

Please provide the following material along with your completed submission form.

1. An outline of the reasons the submission/nomination should be considered for the award (up to 500 words). If this is a nomination, the outline should include how the nominator knows the candidate.
2. Brief biographical material including the candidate's education, professional activities, affiliations and significant projects (up to 500 words).
3. A maximum of five visuals of a selection of recent work presented in jpeg format. The quality of the image must be 300dpi and all five images must be sent on a clearly labeled CD corresponding to the Visual List. CDs will be returned at the conclusion of the awards program. Do not send more than five visuals or any promotional material.

4. Visual List - List of the visuals in numbered order of presentation including description, title, date and medium. Please note that the technical quality of the visuals may influence the selection by the Advisory Panel. Originals of art or design work will not be accepted.

Those who work in architecture, graphic and interior design are not eligible.
